Benefits: Out sourcing in India is considered beneficial because it offers

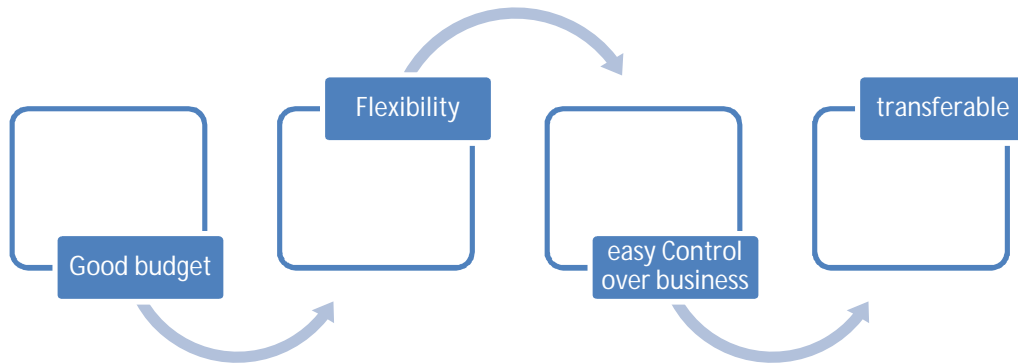
1. Out sourcing in India can be covered within good budget

7. Out sourcing in India helps to bring in best services best expertise & reduces capital & operating cost.

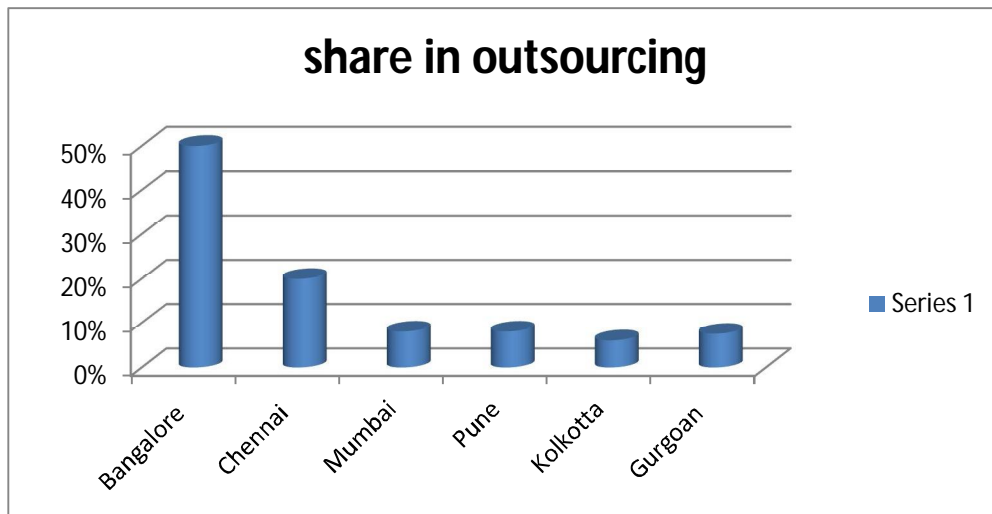
As shown in Chart -1 , Out sourcing is applied in business as it is easier to get
